Essential Ingredients

- **Sodium Carbonate:** A water softener and grease cutter.
- **Sodium Sulfate:** A processing aid and surfactant carrier.
- **Sodium Borate:** A detergent builder and odor reducer.
- **Sodium Alkyl Aryl Sulfonate:** A wetting agent and grease cutter.
- **Primary Linear Alcohol Ethoxylate:** A soil suspender and cleaning agent.
- **Coconut Diethanolamide:** A cleaning agent and foam stabilizer.

Recommendations

- Do not pour detergent directly onto clothes — add it to the washer first, and begin filling with water before adding clothes.
- For cold water washing, first dissolve detergent in a small amount of warm water.
